

# How does the activity test work?

- Two parent family – both must meet the test
  - Parent with the lowest hours of activity will determine subsidised hours
- Sole parent family – must meet the test
- Activities can be combined
- Reasonable travel time can be included
- Casual/irregular hours – can estimate over three-month period
- Evidence of activity is not required at the time of claim
- Entitled to receive subsidy for up to 42 absence days per financial year
